

How to find skin cancer early



1 in 5

To catch it as early as possible—at its most treatable stage, do the **ABCDE** check on suspicious moles monthly and consult a doctor if the mole has²:



(A) SYMMETRY

Two halves that don't match



(B) BORDER

An uneven border




(C) COLOR

Multiple shades of tan, brown, or black; or unusual colors such as red, purple, or blue



(D) DIAMETER

A diameter longer than 6 mm (about the size of a pencil eraser)



(E) EVOLUTION

A different size, shape, or color over time
