Expert subspecialists from these National Cancer Institute–Designated Comprehensive Cancer Centers collaborate with employees' local oncologists to help develop precise plans for treatment. AccessHope is free to eligible employees, and you'll never be asked to change doctors or travel for care.

Here's an overview of the programs AccessHope provides for Adobe employees and their covered dependents:

Cancer Support Team

Our Cancer Support Team includes experienced oncology nurses who can help you prepare for doctor visits, and provide treatment information, and emotional support—wherever you are in your cancer journey and whether you have received a diagnosis or are caring for someone who has.

Expert Advisory Review

You can request that an AccessHope medical expert reviews your case. This specialist will provide recommendations to your treatment plan based on groundbreaking insights and leading discoveries for your specific type of cancer, while communicating with your doctor.

Accountable Precision Oncology

If you're an Aetna member and you've received a rare- or complex-cancer diagnosis, your case will be automatically sent to AccessHope. One of our cancer specialists will then review your case and leverage leading cancer expertise to provide recommendations to your local oncologist, so you can stay with your local support system.
